

HAND WASHING

- Volunteers are to wash hands after:
 1. Using the bathroom (or helping a child use the bathroom)
 2. Changing a diaper
 3. Wiping or blowing their nose (or helping a child wipe or blow his/her nose)
 4. Handling items soiled with any body fluids or wastes (including drool, urine, stool or vomit)
 5. Handling or caring for a sick child
 6. Before and after eating/drinking
 7. Before serving snacks
 8. Before administering first aid
 9. When changing rooms or caring for a different group of children.

- Children wash their hands, use wipes, or use hand sanitizer after each restroom visit and before snacks are served.

TOY DISINFECTANT

- Nursery toys are removed from play after each use until they can be wiped with an anti-bacterial disinfectant.
